Crow Canyon Archaeological Center Recognizes Gene Bradley with Award

(CORTEZ, Colo.)—October 20, 2011—On October 15, Durango resident Gene Bradley was presented the Crow Canyon Archaeological Center Distinguished Service Award in recognition of his singular and outstanding contributions to the Center’s mission and goals. The award was presented at Crow Canyon’s 2011 annual meeting appreciation dinner.

The Crow Canyon Archaeological Center, located four miles outside Cortez, Colo., is a research and education not-for-profit organization dedicated to understanding and teaching the history of the ancestral Pueblo people of the American Southwest.

Bradley first joined Crow Canyon’s Board of Trustees in 1994, and in 1995 was appointed the Center’s interim president. He served as president for nearly nine months until a permanent replacement was found. Since then, he has been active with Crow Canyon’s board as chair of the audit and executive committees and as a member of the investment committee.

“Gene’s vision, leadership, management and sense of innovation represent the qualities and characteristics that define this award,” said Crow Canyon President and CEO Deborah Gangloff. “Gene’s enormous legacy has greatly contributed to Crow Canyon’s growth, success, national reputation and financial well-being.”

Bradley is a retired senior partner of KPMG, an international CPA firm. He is a recognized civic leader in Durango, having served as president and board member of the Durango Choral Society and board member and treasurer of the Adaptive Sports Association of Durango. Currently, he is a board member and treasurer of the Animas-La Plata Water Conservancy District, board member of the Fort Lewis College Foundation, and board member of First National Bank of Durango.
