A composting toilet is available adjacent to the cabins, and a modern shower and restroom building is located a short distance away. Meals are served in a communal dining hall. Briefly discuss how well you would adapt to these conditions.

Field, laboratory, and classroom conditions:** Archaeological research and education at Crow Canyon involve exposure to insects, dust, intense sunlight, and temperature extremes; hiking, carrying heavy objects (weighing as much as 40 pounds), and other forms of physical exertion; and concentrating and communicating in noisy environments.
